All about us

Founded as an independent registered charity by the successful automotive publisher, John Haynes OBE, Haynes Motor Museum has been the custodian of a unique and eclectic collection of vehicles since 1985.

We bring history to life through our collection of cars, motorcycles and automobilia. From the earliest modes of motorised car in 1898 to the cutting-edge vehicles of today, we tell the stories behind the people who designed them, made them and drove them and reflect on their impact on society.

Whether it's children who are immersed in hands-on STEM learning, motoring enthusiasts peeking under the bonnet, or visitors captivated by the tales of those who influence the automobile, we're here to inspire.

The Collection

Housed within 15 exhibition spaces, the Museum showcases more than 300 vehicles and automotive memorabilia. Behind the scenes the Museum is also home to an extensive library and archive containing historic artefacts and records.

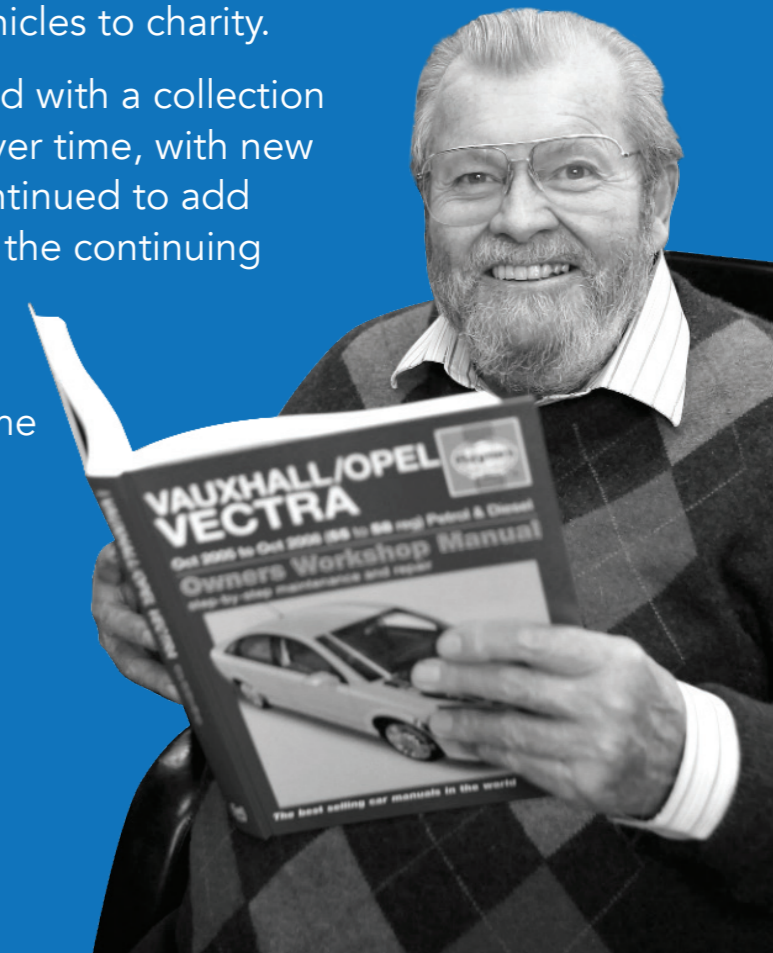
Our story

The idea to create a museum that shared a passion for the car began with John Haynes OBE and his wife, Annette Haynes.

John was the founder of Haynes Publishing and creator of the Haynes Owners Workshop manuals. He also collected cars that appealed to him. By the early 1980s his collection had expanded considerably, and he made the decision to found the Museum and donate the vehicles to charity.

In July 1985 the Museum opened with a collection of 35 cars. The Museum grew over time, with new exhibition halls built as John continued to add to the collection and funded for the continuing development and growth.

By the time John passed away in 2019, the Museum had become world renowned institution, and his legacy is clear to see. The Museum set out to engage people to feel empowered to learn about the history of the automobile as a platform for engineering and science and continues to do so today.

Pension scheme

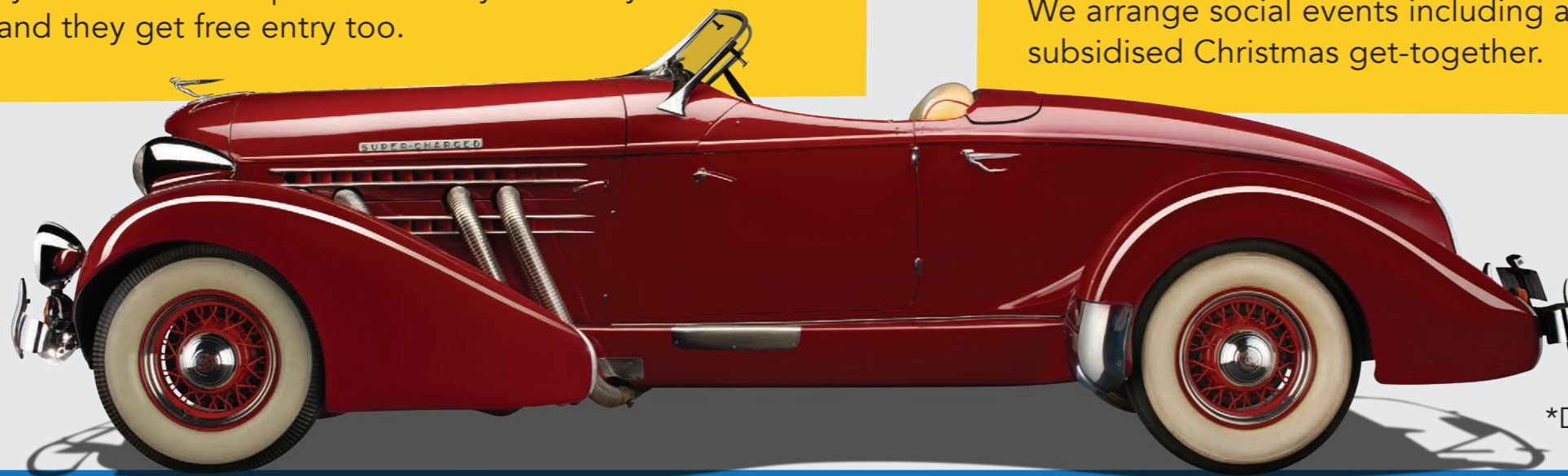
